



Project in Focus | Campbelltown Hospital Redevelopment – Stage 1

The \$134 million redevelopment of Campbelltown Hospital included a new multi-storey acute services building with new inpatient wards, ambulatory care, outpatients, allied health services, antenatal, pathology and a clinical information department. The Main Works contract was delivered by Lend Lease (formerly Abigroup) under a design finalisation and construct contract.

The project also included a number of other works packages including Early Works (new helipad, 2 new on-grade car parks, expanded loading dock and campus service ring), mechanical upgrade, lift upgrade and Refurbishment Works (remodelling of existing maternity, emergency department, paediatric outpatients, 2 new interventional cardiology cath labs and support services).
