



Project in Focus | Nation Building Economic Stimulus Plan - Queensland School Infrastructure

One of Thelem's Principals, Craig Robinson as Executive Director, Infrastructure Programs & Delivery for Queensland Department of Education and Training, was directly responsible for the national stimulus program of School Infrastructure in Queensland. Between 2009 and 2012, 4500 projects were constructed across 1250 sites in the \$2.1 billion program. It was Education's largest ever capital building program.

All tiers of the consultant and construction industry were engaged using a variety of methodologies, such as traditional, design and construct, and managing contractor, ensuring the stimulus funds were used strategically across the state and supply chains. The Federal Taskforce report to Federal Parliament July 2011 reported that "this was the only state government that can claim to have all the attributes of an informed buyer of capital works projects currently is the Queensland Government."
