



Project in Focus | Pacific Highway Woolgoolga to Ballina Upgrade

Roads and Maritime Services NSW is responsible for the delivery of the \$4.4 billion Woolgoolga to Ballina Upgrade of the Pacific Highway. The project includes all approvals, land acquisition, design, construction and commissioning of 155 kilometres of four lane divided highway including over 100 bridges.

This is the last section required to complete the four lane divided highway between Sydney and Brisbane – it is also the largest regional road project being delivered in Australia and at its peak is projected to employ 4000 workers.

The Project is being delivered using an innovative Delivery Partner Contract who acts as an agent of RMS and manages amongst other items, procurement of contractors and suppliers.

Thelem Consulting was appointed as Project Director for the Pacific Highway upgrade project in 2017.
